


# Using Your RediHaler™

#### Follow these steps to correctly use your RediHaler

- You do not need to shake your RediHaler™.
- Mouthpiece
  White Cap
- **2.** Remove the cap from the mouthpiece.
- **3.** Breathe out normally away from the RediHaler™.
- **4.** Place the mouthpiece in your mouth behind your teeth and seal your lips tightly around the mouthpiece.



**5.** Make sure your hand does not cover the vent on the top of the inhaler.

- **6.** Keep the RediHaler<sup>™</sup> upright and take one deep breath.
- 7. Move the RediHaler™ away from your mouth and hold your breath for 10 seconds.
- 8. Turn your head and breathe out.
- **9.** Put the cap back onto the mouthpiece. This must be done to make sure the next puff comes out correctly.
- **10.** Repeat steps 1 through 9 for each inhalation or puff the doctor ordered.
- **11.** Brush your teeth or rinse your mouth out with water after use. Do not swallow the water.

## **Cleaning instructions**

- 1. Remove cap from RediHaler™.
- **2.** Use a clean, dry tissue or cloth to clean the mouthpiece.
- **3.** Do this one time every week.
- **4. Do not** wash or get any part of the RediHaler™ wet.
- **5.** Replace the cap after you clean the mouthpiece.

## Keep your RediHaler in a dry place

- Keep the cap on the RediHaler™ at all times.
- Do not keep your RediHaler™ in rooms that get very warm.
- Do not get the RediHaler<sup>™</sup> wet. Keep away from moist areas.

#### Do not run out of medicine

• When the dose counter changes to the number 20, the numbers will turn red.







- When the numbers are in red, it is time to get a refill.
- Throw the RediHaler™ away when the number changes to zero.
