










What is Asthma?

Inhaler

An inhaler is a portable device that delivers medication directly into the lungs.



Spacer

A spacer is a plastic device that attaches to an inhaler, used to improve the delivery of medication to the lungs.

Rescue vs. Controller

- Used for Emergency
- Short-Term Treatment
- Relieves Asthma Symptoms
- Taken Daily
- Long-Term Treatment
- Prevents Asthma Symptoms


